Directors Report

The Society put on a very successful event in May 2023, with the first ever schools bake off competition involving Alcester Academy and Alcester Grammar School taking place. The enthusiasm of the staff and pupils was clear, and with the attendance of a local celebrity judge and coverage from the BBC and press raised the profile of Alcester and the Food Festival to new heights. The size of the event meant that it attracted more attention than in previous years from several departments at Stratford District Council and other statutory bodies and resulted in the board having to spend more time addressing their requirements during 2023, however their feedback on the running of the event was positive. Preparations for the October event were complete when Storm Babet forced its last minute cancellation. The value placed on the events we run meant that most of the stall holders wanted their booking and fees held over to May 2024. With much of the cost of running the October event being incurred and no income, this resulted in a trading loss for the year.

Grants totalling £10,000 were made during the year for the benefit of the young people of Alcester and the Community Fridge and it was pleasing to get feedback on how these grants made a difference. Donations were also made to organisations assisting with the running of the event.

Volunteers are a critical part of the running and delivery of the festivals, and I was pleased when Ben Williams agreed to join the board at the AGM to focus on this area. I want to thank them for the skills and enthusiasm and sheer hard work that they contribute to make the events so successful.
